The program will consist of two major features:

1. Regular Meetups:

Using a designated group on LinkedIn you will join other writers – all of which are either SGI or ALMA guild members, to make acquaintances and create connections.

This will be the basis for future creative cooperation and assist you in learning the ropes and building confidence in working with colleagues from overseas.

During these meetups, you will introduce yourself, share projects, share your experience, and assist other writers.

From time to time, the members of the group will convene for a special lecture via zoom, on a subject related to writing for the screen.

2. Writing Forums:

Adapting a proven Israeli Writing Forum, 15 writers will participate in a monthly online meeting in which they will share pages from their work, and give and receive notes. This takes place over zoom, in a supportive environment with an experienced moderator who is also a screenwriter.

Pages shared are in English, and notes are given verbally, also in English. The authors whose projects are being discussed can follow up with the feedback and continue to build their scripts.

Both the SGI and ALMA believe this new initiative will provide all participating writers with better writing skills, better people skills, and an opportunity to widen their network of connections and collaborators.
